#### Project Description:

The applicant proposes disturbances to a tributary of the Susquehanna River, also known as Wylie Brook, [NYS Water Index #: SR-123, Class C and C(T)] in association to a stream restoration project to reduce extreme bank erosion and incision. The proposed work will stabilize the bed and banks of Wylie Brook and restore floodplain connectivity utilizing the following methods: constructed inner berm/bank grading (~900 linear feet), toewood installation (~50 linear feet), six (6) log rollers and six (6) top of riffle rocks for grade control, one (1) J-Hook, and one (1) rock cross vane. Proper erosion and sedimentation controls will be implemented to protect downstream water quality, including a pump around system to bypass clean water around the project site. This project is located 650 feet northwest of the intersection of State Route 235 and Wylie-Horton Rd. in the Town of Coventry, Chenango County.
